From Our Family Liaison Officer

Hopefully we have all settled back into our of pride, build positive self esteem and are regular routines for school, but for some it can be a challenge after the casual ways of school holidays. It's nice to take things easy in the morning without a schedule and time pressures for a couple of weeks, but establishing a regular routine has many benefits for children.

A routine lets a child know what to expect, provides them with a sense that life is predictable and prove calming for a child and give them a sense of security. When a child knows what to expect, their world is more comfortable. This is why children tend to thrive with routines.

Uncertainty about what will be happening and when, can leave children feeling unsure, anxious and stressed. That's not a good way for anyone to start their day and can lead to challenging behaviour from children.

Routines allow children to participate in day to day activities and they are more willing to do things on their own when they are able to predict events and consequences after following routines you establish. This in turn can help encourage independence in children and develop their sense of self. When they can do things for themselves children feel a sense more willing to take on new tasks.

There is more information about the benefits of routines for children in the article "Why routines for kids are important".

There are lots of opportunities for parents/ carers and grandparents to be involved at school this term with Grandparents and Father's Day celebrations, book week parade, a book fair and sport Gala Days for our older children. All families are invited and encouraged to come along and participate in our many activities.

Don't forget our regular weekly activities like Tuesday morning "Cuppa and Chat" for parents and carers to meet and catch up straight after morning assembly and Thursday morning "Storytime in the Library" for toddlers and pre-schoolers, again straight after morning assembly.
