Over the past 12 months we have had a dramatic increase in the number of children riding to school on their bikes. Sometimes children are noticed racing their bikes against each other. 
From Our Librarian

HOW TO CHOOSE THE RIGHT BOOK

Reading is to the mind what exercise is to the body Sir Richard Steele

Have you found 20 minutes in each day to listen to your child read? 2020 is a brand new year to catch the reading bug!!! Many parents ask what sorts of books should my child read? The text in a book needs to have the right amount of challenge for children to feel successful when reading. Sometimes we like the look of a book when we see it's cover but when we open it up to read we find it is not ready for us yet. In the Library we learn to use the Five Finger Test. Here is a diagram that you can also follow at home.

And why are books that are easy to read especially valuable for reading at home? When children are confident readers their reading sounds phrased and fluent. They flow smoothly across the text. Easy reading texts reinforce fluency and then allow children to experiment with expression and characterization. Don't be worried if your child chooses an old favourite or an easy-to-read book. Their reading and comprehension skills are being reinforced.
