From Our Family Liaison Officer

While the vast majority of students have been eager to get back to school and see their friends and teachers, returning to school after being out of routine and in isolation for so long can be tricky for some kids. Worry and anxiety can make it difficult for them to easily transition back to school - worries may include being separated from mum or dad after spending so much time with them these past two months, that someone could get sick, concerns about how they will fit back in with their friends after not seeing them for so long or how they will cope with school work when they return to class. Children, particularly younger children, may not be able to express their worries or fears verbally so it can come out in challenging behaviour. Both the ABC and Hey Sigmund websites have some practical tips for parents about helping children get back to school. We also have some great books in our Parent Resource Library for both parents and children on how to deal with fears and worries. Please let me know if vou would like to borrow one and I can arrange for it to go home to you.

Unfortunately our Term 2 Playgroups have had to be cancelled due to the Covid 19 safety measures, but parents with young children can access some great ideas for learning through play at home through the new <u>Playgroup At Home NSW</u> facebook page. Our school playgroups are a great way for our new Kinder children and parents to have some fun, meet and get to know each other and see what our school is all about. Hopefully things will have improved over the next couple of months and we will be able to go ahead with our Term 3 playgroups.
