Afternoon Pick-Up Procedure: Great minds think alike. Yesterday, we had a host of parents in cars lined up early (from 2.20pm) to collect their child. The cars were spilling out onto Main Road by 2.23pm. Those who walked up to the gates or drove in at around 3.05-3.10pm barely waited at all. And a reminder that the Pandora Parade exit is open for walk-ups. It was hardly used yesterday.

No Balls at School: Children are not allowed to bring any balls (including handballs) to school until further notice. Handball will still be played by the kids. We will have new handballs available for the children and, after each session, the balls will be soaked in disinfectant and water.
