## The Season of Advent

Advent is the season of the liturgical year where we wait in anticipation and preparation for the coming of our Saviour; it is time to wait, prepare and reflect so that we can allow the light of God into our lives. Advent means 'Coming' in Latin. Tomorrow our school begins celebrating the season of Advent with our weekly Advent Liturgies. This will be the first of four Advent Liturgies. 
