Just a reminder that we are still collecting blankets and clothing for the St Vincent De Paul Winter Appeal. If you have donations could you please bring them to school.



But children are generally very perceptive and will pick up that things aren't quite right, even if we think we are doing a good job of quietly managing what is happening.

Wish us luck! Some of us will need it more than others.


