HBL—While there are some kids who are really motivated and very keen to do lots of extra work, we don't want parents getting stressed by feeling that you need to be "teaching" or supervising for hours every day. HBL is not meant to replace the school learning environment. Fit it around your household. Take breaks and do something fun with the kids and if it's getting on top of you take the day off and get back to it tomorrow. The teachers are just an email or phone call away to help when you need it.

Getting on top of the current Covid situation is proving to be a much bigger challenge and taking much longer than first thought. You may be feeling the stress and strain or noticed those close to you having a hard time managing. It is important to look out for each other and practice positive strategies for taking care of our social, emotional and mental wellbeing.

Many organisations such as Beyond Blue have very helpful and practical ideas and


supports to help us through. You can access them online <u>"here"</u> or by phoning the Coronavirus Mental Wellbeing Support Service on 1800 512 348.


You are also always welcome to contact the school to discuss any concerns you may have whether that be financial, wellbeing or your child's learning. We are here to help.
