Dear St Mary's Catholic School Community,

On Saturday 27th November and Saturday 4th December children from our school and parish will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation.

- Kinder 2022 Transition Day 3 Wednesday 24 November 9.30am-11.00am
- Sacrament of Confirmation Saturday 27 November
- Kinder 2022 Transition Day 4 Wednesday 1 December 9.30am-11.00am
- Sacrament of Confirmation Saturday 4 December
- Students Last Day Wednesday 15 December

Confirmation witnesses the children being blessed with the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

Confirmation, a sacrament of initiation, establishes recipients as full-fledged members of the Catholic faith. This sacrament is called Confirmation because the faith given in baptism is now confirmed and made strong. During your baptism, your parents and godparents made promises and now, during the Sacrament of Confirmation, these promises are renewed. The symbolic actions of Confirmation include:

The Laying On of Hands

The bishop places his hands on the head of the candidates and prays for the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

This ritualises the connection to Baptism and the strengthening of the Holy Spirit in our vocation to follow the way of Jesus.

Anointing with Oil

The anointing of the candidate at Confirmation Kevin Williams recognises that they are sealed with the Holy Co Principal Spirit. The bishop anoints the candidate's forehead with the Oil of Chrism, saying "Be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit".

If you are baptised you are an eligible candidate for Confirmation. Please keep our children preparing for the beautiful Sacrament of Confirmation in your thoughts and prayers.
