After children have been baptised the next sacrament to be made is Confirmation. This can be celebrated from Year 3. This sacrament is given by Bishop Anthony. Following this, children celebrate their first Reconciliation and then First Eucharist in Year 4. Our Sacraments need to be completed in a particular order. If a Sacrament is missed it can be completed the following year.

HOW TO CHOOSE THE RIGHT BOOK Have you found 20 minutes in each day to listen to your child read? We are well into our brand, new year and the only bug we want to catch is the reading bug!!! Many parents ask what sorts of books should my child read? The text in a book needs to have the right amount of challenge for children to feel successful when reading. Sometimes we like the look of a book when we see it's cover but when we open it up to read, we find it is not ready for us yet because there are too many tricky words. In the Library we learn to use the Five Finger Test. Here is a diagram that you can also follow at home.
