From Our Family Liaison Officer

As we are more than half way through Term 4 and closing in on the end of the school year, it is nice to reflect back on the progress made and the changes in the children since January. As well as the physical changes, all students have grown in their abilities and independence, socially and emotionally. This is particularly true of our youngest students.

Starting 'big school' is a huge transition for them with lots of learning and expectations. They have shown great improvement in doing things for themselves, learning the routines and rules of school, managing their own social and emotional needs and they have become much more independent and resilient. These changes don't happen without the support and guidance of their teachers and most importantly parents. Sometimes as parents we continue to see our children as totally dependant on us and needing us to make sure everything is perfect for them, but

when we give children the 'gift of independence' it lets them know that we value and believe in them and they grow up with a strong sense of self belief and that they are capable kids, able to do anything they put their mind to. Think about how well they manage their hours at school each day. They have shown that they can do so much.

This is very true for our oldest students as well. Heading off to high school next year they will need to be more independent, organised, resilient and just as parents support children starting Kinder, students transitioning to high school need their parents support just as much – albeit in different ways. 
